Others present were: Margaret Dau, Neomia Foley, Bonnie Wallinga, Dan Wetherell, Mark Shriver, Dennis Fogelman, Collene Johnson, Jo Homan, Connie Cody, Darin Johnson, Mari Radtke, Mike & Sharon Flinders, and Officer Jami Webster.

A motion was made by Sweeney seconded by Jurgensen to approve the agenda, previous minutes and clerk's report. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Darin Johnson requested permission to obtain bids for repairing the restrooms at the baseball field. A motion was made by Sweeney seconded by Koch to approve the little league obtaining bids to find out what it would take to fix the restrooms. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Engelke to pay the bills. Roll call: Ayes – Bruce Engelke, Jack Wallinga, Jill Jurgensen, Steve Koch and Joe Sweeney. Motion carried.

Economic Development report was provided by Jo Homan. A motion was made by Koch seconded by Sweeney to have the city seek possession of the Innes building. Roll call: Ayes – Jill Jurgensen, Steve Koch and Joe Sweeney. Nays - Bruce Engelke and Jack Wallinga. Motion carried.

Library Report was given by Dan Wetherell. He asked for council's approval for new members Richard Radtke and Mary Beermann and returning members Connie Cody and Margaret Dau. A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Engelke to approve all the members for the Library Board. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Fire and Ambulance Report was given by Chief Mark Shriver. They will have training on the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. This month they will be tearing cars apart with the Jaws of Life and other rescue equipment. The public is welcome to observe. Chief Shriver asked for the council's approval to seek sealed bids for the old rescue. The department may set a minimum bid amount and will reserve the right to reject any and all bids. A motion was made by Engelke seconded by Sweeney to put the rescue up for sealed bids and all dates to be set by the Fire & Ambulance Department. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Police Report was presented by Officer Jami Webster. She has obtained a grant for a new camera for the car and can order it in October. Officer Webster stated that an update should be enough to fix the current issues with her handheld radio. The cost of updating is between \$200 & \$300. Engelke made a motion seconded by Jurgensen to update the handheld radio. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Communications and topics for discussion:

A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Koch to approve the wage review committee recommendations of 2.5% for Corey, 2% for Jami starting on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>, and 3% for Natosha. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Sweeney seconded by Engelke to approve renewing the liquor license for R.L. Johannsen Community Center. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Sweeney to approve a temporary outdoor liquor license for Mugshots for Ragbrai. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Sweeney to approve a temporary outdoor liquor license for Sweeney's Clubhouse for Ragbrai. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Koch to approve a permanent outdoor liquor license for Sweeney's Clubhouse. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Engelke to approve closing Main Street between First and Second Street for Ragbrai. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Koch seconded by Engelke to waive the second reading of Ordinance 2017-005. Roll call: Ayes – Steve Koch, Joe Sweeney, Bruce Engelke, Jack Wallinga and Jill Jurgensen. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jurgensen seconded by Engelke to waive the third reading of Ordinance 2017-005. Roll call: Ayes – Joe Sweeney, Bruce Engelke, Jack Wallinga, Jill Jurgensen and Steve Koch. Motion carried.

Jurgensen left at 8:07 p.m.

A motion was made by Koch seconded by Sweeney to table the Town & Country contract since Brad was not present. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Standing Committee Reports:

Park – Officer Webster presented the bid for cameras in the park. A motion was made by Sweeney seconded by Koch to approve the bid of \$1972.00. All were in favor. Motion carried. The cost will be paid out of the general fund for the additional cameras and upgrade to the camera system.

A motion was made by Engelke seconded by Sweeney to adjourn. All were in favor. Motion carried.
